What alternative career paths are there, and how can the research and innovation activities of scientists in Germany be further promoted? By discussing these and other questions, a new space for solutions will be created, aiming to constructively contribute to the differentiation of the ongoing German debate on academic career support especially in light of the Academic-Fixed-Term-Contract-Act (WissZeitVG).
